On a crisp November morning, local residents and the Clarion County Probation Department gathered to tackle the dumpsite at the corner of Amsler and McElhattan Roads in Beaver Township, just outside of Knox. Looking at the site, it is plain to see why people dump here because it is easy to access by vehicle.

After several hours, we realized that what looked like a relatively small dump was actually decades of trash and layers deep. A local resident driving by stopped to tell us it has been here for at least 75 years. By the end of the day, the roll off was full and all were exhausted. Although we were unable to remove a few partially buried larger items, the efforts of these volunteers made a huge difference.
