The Dominion Road site in Somerset County was a large historical dumpsite located in an old mining pit. With a contractor on site to remove the majority of the trash, the remaining items were removed by a group of volunteers.

Stoy Excavating was contracted to remove appliances, furniture, lumber, large tires, and to make the site more accessible for volunteers. A makeshift road was built into the site from the main road to allow equipment into the bottom. The final stage of the cleanup was on November 7th, when a group from Somerset County Probation came out to hand pick what was left. Together, volunteers removed an additional 0.9 tons from the site.

The Somerset County Illegal Dump Survey was completed in 2008 and found that the county has a serious illegal dumping problem. Overall, 210 sites were identified, totaling more than 540 tons of trash. Stonycreek Township had a total of 7 sites with approximately 14 tons of trash.
