Twenty-one dedicated volunteers came out on a warm sunny November day to finish removing the illegally dumped items along Frank Road in Thompson Township. Frank Road has been the site of years of illegal dumping, however with this latest cleanup the trash has been removed and local residents are monitoring the road for subsequent dumping. As the result of two volunteer cleanups, 5.22 tons of trash has been properly disposed of and, 100 tires recycled by 31 volunteers.

Fulton County is 438 square miles of fertile farmland and mature hardwood forests nestled in the Appalachian Mountains. Because of the hard work and dedication of the volunteers, the residents and wildlife of Fulton County can enjoy a cleaner and healthier environment.
