On a very wet Friday morning, fifteen volunteers put on their rain gear and got down and dirty to help eliminate an old, inactive illegal dumpsite along Iron Mountain Road. Greenwood Township was also involved in the cleanup, donating much needed equipment and manpower. In addition to the main dumpsite with many layers of trash, volunteers scoured along a half mile section of roadside and woods down to the creek, collecting additional trash and tires. The tires were taken to Mahantango Enterprises, Inc., in Liverpool to be recycled into mulch, horse turf, Fuel-TDF (Tire Derived Fuel) chips, and other materials.

The Iron Mountain Road illegal dumpsite was identified on PA CleanWays' 2009 Illegal Dump Survey of Perry County. The purpose of the survey was to assess and document as many illegal dumpsites as possible within Perry County. PA CleanWays and PA CleanWays of Perry County applaud all volunteers and community donors and sponsors for recognizing the importance of eliminating littering and illegal dumping in Pennsylvania.
