Oil Creek State Park - Contractor, Let George Do It, Inc., removed and properly disposed of 43.2 tons of trash and recycled 29.63 tons of scrap metal from the Maintenance Barn, Petroleum Center, Red Ski Trail, and Ski Hut dumpsites. In addition, Oil Creek State Park personnel collected and loaded approximately 550 tires throughout the park for proper disposal. The trash removed included tires, appliances, vehicle parts, household trash, bed springs, bottles, culvert pipes, construction debris, vehicle trailers, drums, finished wood, and yard waste.

The cleanup was funded through the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources who works in partnership with PA CleanWays to identify dumpsites and form community volunteer teams to help remove the waste under the Forest Lands Beautification Program.
