Tioga State Forest - Seven dedicated volunteers donated a total of 28 hours to properly dispose of 1.75 tons of trash and 6 tires from a wooded, abandoned lease camp along Pinafore Run, a small tributary to Pine Creek. Volunteers met at the Tioga State Forest District Office on SR 287 and then proceeded to the dump site, which was located along the gorgeous Pine Creek Trail. At the site, the volunteers received a safety talk and cleanup supplies prior to cleaning the site. Despite morning showers, the day turned out to be beautiful, and the volunteers, in addition to the Tioga State Forest staff on hand, had a wonderful time. The dump not only threatened the water quality of the Pine Creek Watershed but also lowered the aesthetics of the area.

This cleanup was combined with the Lungerville cleanup, which also occurred on October 27, 2007. The totals reflect both cleanups, which were funded through the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources under the Forest Lands Beautification Program.
