With the help of 10 volunteers from the Adelphoi Village Miller Home, the crew removed over a half ton of trash and 60 tires! The site was located along a windy forested road in Armstrong County that is now more attractive and safer for wildlife.

The South Long Run Road site is one of two dumpsites along this stretch of road in the southern part of the county. The 2009 Armstrong County Illegal Dump Survey found that South Bend Township had 8 illegal dumpsites that totaled 25 tons. Armstrong County as a whole has 176 illegal dumpsites with a total of 584.75 tons of trash.

Armstrong County is a historically resource-rich area in the middle of western Pennsylvania. The county has been mined for coal, oil, natural gas, and home to a large manufacturing industry in the 19th century. Even today, energy production and advanced manufacturing are still the largest industries in the county.
