A very steep and windy mountain road was chosen by someone as a dumping ground for their old appliances and tires. The slope is so precipitous and the debris has rolled so far down that clean up by volunteers is out of the question. A contractor was hired to remove the waste and separate the scrap metal for recycling. The tires were collected from the 1/2 mile long site, strung on a cable, and winched to the top of the hill.

Deterring or stopping active dumping at this site is challenging as the remoteness makes it an attractive target for illegal dumpers. The contractor has adopted over a mile length of this road and organizes volunteer cleanups on a regular basis to remove any litter and new dumping along the road edge. The contractor will remove any items that may roll further down the slope. PA CleanWays Adoption signs have been placed at either end to inform and educate the public.
