Buchanan State Forest - In only three days, Gary Fronk Excavating completely eradicated an eyesore in the Buchanan State Forest. The Three Mountain Road (a.k.a. Mountain House Road) illegal dumpsite, located along a 0.5 mile portion of the busy road and on a steep slope, contained tires, appliances, rusted metal, bottles and cans, and household trash. Buchanan State Forest personnel also provided traffic control and helped load tires during the cleanup. PA CleanWays will continue to work with the Buchanan State Forest to secure an adopting group for the area. Since 1990, PA CleanWays has offered an adoption program as a way for caring individuals and groups to "adopt" local areas they care about and help to keep them clean.

This cleanup was funded through the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources who works in partnership with PA CleanWays to identify dumpsites and form community volunteer teams to help remove the waste under the Forest Lands Beautification Program.
