This site, an access point for a railroad line as well as the right-of-way for the state park's waterline, provided out of sight dumping opportunities for illegal dumpers. Waste had been dumped and burned here for years. Through the Forest Lands Beautification Program, a cleanup was organized to reclaim the site. Volunteers hand-picked and bagged waste and loaded tires while the state park used a front end loader to loosen buried debris and help fill a 30 yard dumpster. A local contractor removed heavy items after the volunteers had left the site. The site is now trash-free and the state park has installed a gate to prevent future dumping.

April 19th was the annual park-wide volunteer day and all morning long dozens of others worked on various projects throughout the park. The sunshine and balmy breezes helped the work to go quickly. At lunchtime, everyone took a break and joined together at Raccoon Beach to enjoy pizza, soda, and each other's camaraderie.
